INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANT

ELIGIBILITY: Eligible applicants must be a military member (active duty, retired, National Guard or Reserve) who has served in a Special Forces, Psychological Operations or Civil Affairs unit, or be a spouse, child, stepchild or grandchild of a qualified individual. Proof of assignment in a Special Forces, Psychological Operations or Civil Affairs unit is required. This may be supported by special orders, DD Form 214's or other official records documenting the assignment of the individual or sponsor. Applications from a previous year will not be considered. A new application and essay must be submitted for the upcoming school year.

REQUIREMENTS: Applicants and sponsors must complete and sign the Statement of Certification. Failure to complete this requirement will result in rejection of the application. Copy of transcripts from high school, college or vocational institutions must be attached. SAT/ACT/GRE scores must accompany the applications. Do not mix scores. If you have more than one, simply submit the highest score attained. Include a 300 word essay explaining why you deserve this scholarship and your plans for utilizing it should you be selected. In submitting the application, the Scholarship Committee will screen for attention to detail in fulfilling the requirements outlined herein. Applications must be submitted and received NLT April 15 of each year for the Fall selection.

APPLICATION EVALUATION: Each application is evaluated based on merit. The Scholarship Committee will evaluate each application based on the following six (6) categories:

1. SAT/ACT/GRE scores;
2. Membership involvement in school/club/other activities;
3. Membership involvement in community/church activities;
4. Leadership positions held;
5. Athletic/band/cheerleading, etc.
6. Outside employment.

NOTE: If selected, the applicant will be notified and a 2x3 photo (waist high) will be required. This photo will be used in recognizing the scholarship winners in the Museum Musings.
